Comments:

Instruction and Program Committee Chair Anderson convened the meeting at 4:05 PM. The Strategic Plan Priorities that were identified included Priority 1: Unified and Aligned Systems, Priority 2: A Rigorous and Relevant Framework for Curriculum and Instruction, Priority 3: Strength-Based and Responsive Culture, Priority 4: Continuous Learning for All, Priority 5: Integrated System of Supports, and Priority 6: Strong Reciprocal Partnerships.

Immediately following, Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning, Esteves, reviewed the Instruction and Program Committee meeting norms.

At 4:10 PM, Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning, Esteves, co-facilitated a presentation on Math initiatives alongside Amanda Grossi, the Director of the Office of Math. The presentation provided a comprehensive overview of the Mathematics program, highlighting the following key areas:

- Numbers & Operations
- Geometry & Measurement
- Algebraic Reasoning
- Data Literacy & Probability
- Differentiation of Instruction
- Monitoring Student Progress
- Cornell Notes
- Academic Walkthrough
- Teacher Training and Professional Learning Communities

The Strategic Plan Priorities that were addressed throughout this presentation were Priority 1: Unified and Aligned Systems, Priority 2: A Rigorous and Relevant Framework for Curriculum and Instruction, and Priority 4: Continuous Learning for All.

At 4:54 PM, Assistant Superintendent of Teaching and Learning, Esteves, opened the floor for questions and addressed inquiries submitted in the chat. During this time, questions were asked and answered. Additionally, Executive Director Rochanda Jackson provided a brief overview of the district-wide gains in mathematics.
